 - Project participants (PP): > 100.000 fully valid responses
 - Project leaders (PL) > 15.000 fully valid responses
- RAY projects with mixed methods and qualitative data
 - > 5.000 thematic survey respondents
 - > 1.000 interviews (semi-structured or explorative)
