- Tokenism





- Comparing projects focussing explicitly on inclusion with projects without this focus












- Data collection and analysis of Erasmus+ projects (2022)
- Focus on inclusion in education
- 15 case studies
- Commissioned by the European Commission, implemented by a consortium consisting of the Danish Technological Institute, 3s Unternehmensberatung and Ecorys Europe.

- Learning environments
- Learners and learning climate
- Enhancing teacher agency in tackling educational disadvantage,
- School governance and leadership, including quality assurance
- Involvement of parents and families,
- Collaboration in and around schools with stakeholders and the wider community.



Directions for research Differences between participants

- Effects of social inequalities of learning outcomes
- Based on RAY MON data (2017-2018)
- Learning outcomes:
 - Active participation
 - ◆ Learning and personal development
 - Intercultural interaction





Directions for research Differences between participants

SALTO
INCLUSION &
DIVERSITY

- Although small, better learning outcomes for:
 - Participants experiencing educational inequality
 - Participants experiencing employment inequality
 - → Participants experiencing participation inequality
 - → Participants experiencing inequality due to migration or belonging to a minority
 - Participants exploring mobility inequality

Connecting Inclusion & Diversity with Environment and climate action

- The most vulnerable...
 - Are most at risk of climate change
 - → Have fewer resources, choices, opportunities
 - → Are least represented in current large movements
 - → Have least access to decision making





Connecting Inclusion & Diversity with Digital Transformation

- Digitalisation created a new social field
 - Opportunities because of new meeting spaces
 - Challenges because of new expectations
 - (New) barriers rising up
