The project aims to enhance evidence-informed policymaking (EIPM) in seven EU Member States: **Spain, Austria, Cyprus, France, Ireland, Poland, Portugal**

It is funded by SG Reform and implemented by JRC

Duration of the project: **30 months** (starting from the signature of the Administrative Agreement)

Why EIPM?

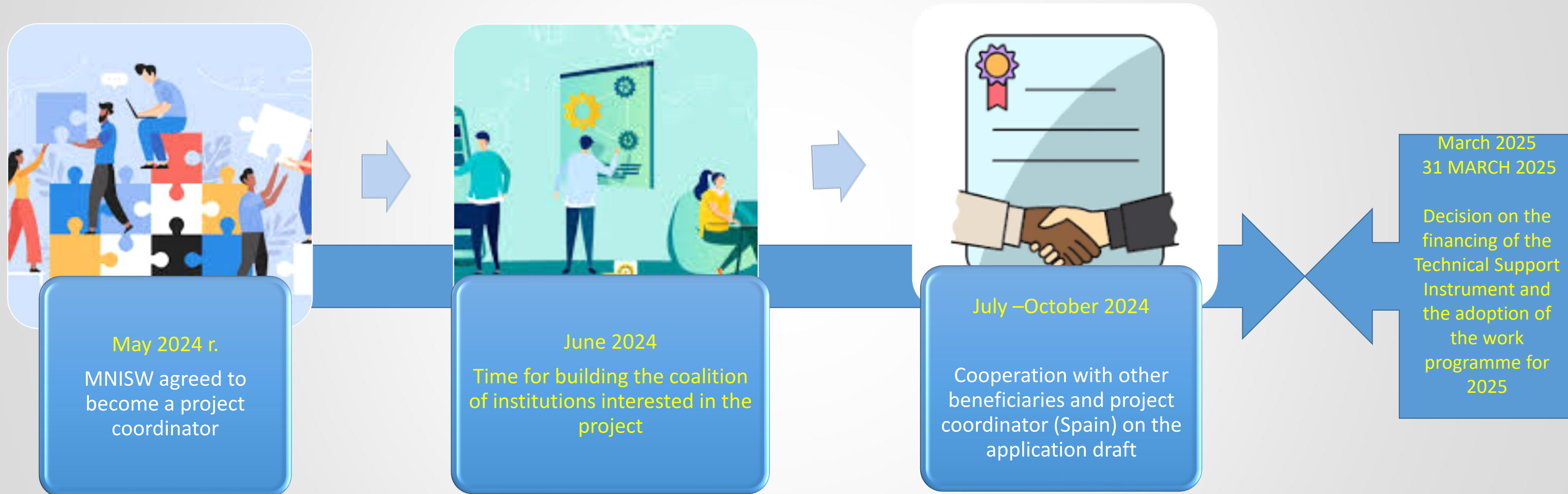


Policy without evidence is guesswork. Evidence without policy is paperwork.

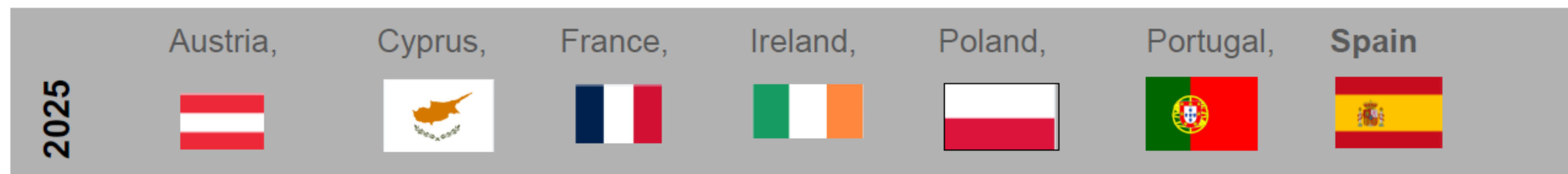
